Wednesday morning Bible Study is on Summer Sabbatical.

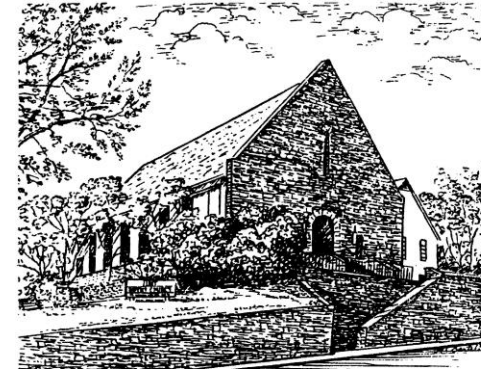
The "I Love My Church" offering will be collected on June 30<sup>th</sup>.
