Our Christmas in July mission collected \$520 for the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering, and \$613 for CBF Missions.

The WMU is the sponsor of the Church-wide mission outreach for August which is school supplies for Tryon Elementary. 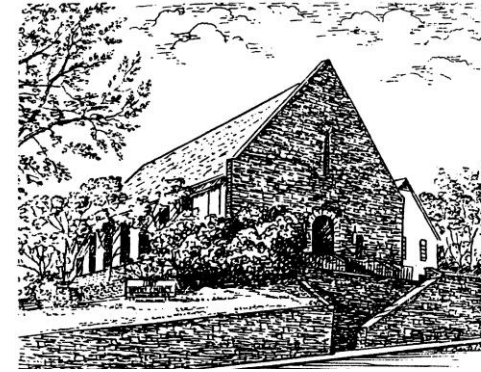
