New guidelines for First Baptist Church of Tryon scholarship application submissions have been suggested by the Scholarship Committee, with the approval of the Board of Deacons and the Stewardship Committee. Last year, the general scholarship fund was depleted, leaving the named/memorial scholarships as the only funding now available for college and passport scholarships. In an effort to utilize these funds as effectively as possible and for as long as possible, the new guidelines for the scholarship application process will include several changes. Applications should be submitted by May 11.

\*The scholarship award will be a one-time, \$1,000.00 award to qualifying applicants for college expenses, paid to the college or university in which the student is enrolled.

\*The scholarship will be a one-time award. There will no longer be a renewal scholarship. However, last year's first-time recipients are able to apply this year for a one time renewal of \$500.

\*Members or active participants of First Baptist of Tryon or children of members/participants are eligible and are encouraged to apply.

\*Scholarship funds will also be used to assist children participating in the "Passport" camp each summer.

Please consider giving to any of the memorial/named scholarships so that First Baptist Church of Tryon can continue to support the children and youth of our church through the scholarship program. -The Scholarship Committee
