Reminder—July worship will start at 10am, and there's no Sunday School during the month.

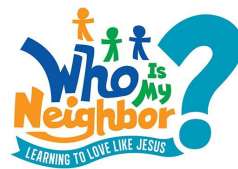

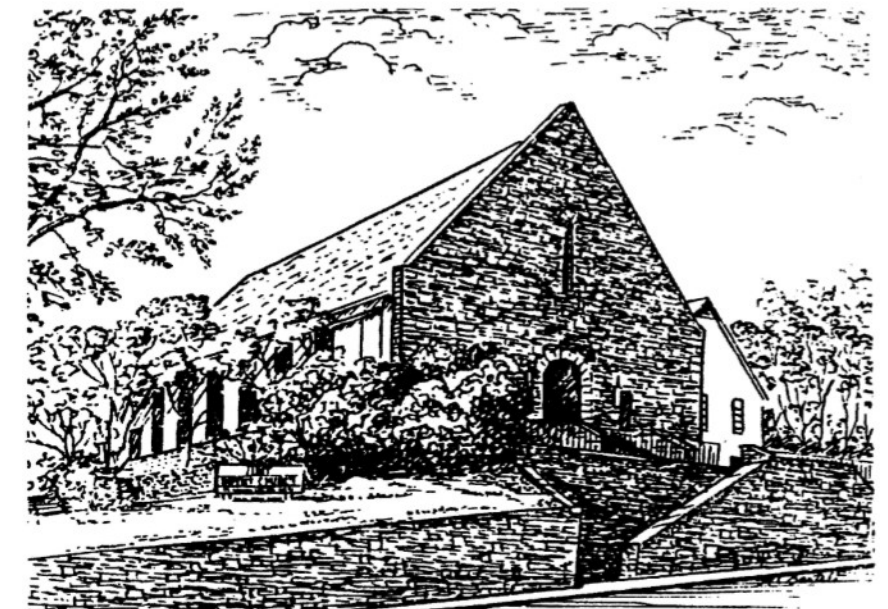
